

## OREGON DECA BATTLE OF THE CHAPTERS QUIZ SHOW!

### Description

Test your pop-culture, academic, and DECA trivia skills in a fun and interactive competition at this year's State Conference. Does your chapter have what it takes to prevail in the third annual Oregon DECA Battle of the Chapters? Prizes will be awarded to top teams!

### Rules & Format

Only one team per chapter. Each team may consist of 1 to 4 members. 4 is the maximum team size. All teams MUST be pre-registered. The link to the registration form is below.

Participants will be asked multiple-choice questions that range in topic from general trivia, academia, or DECA knowledge. Think Trivial Pursuit type questions. We also encourage participants to study the DECA knowledge exam study guide located here:

Teams will compete in a bracket-style competition on stage at the Monday night social activity. Competing teams will be randomly drawn. Winning teams will move on to the next round of competition. If less than 16 teams enter the tournament there may be a consolation bracket. If there are 16 or more teams there will be no consolation bracket and the competition will be single elimination.

Once a chapter is called to the stage, they will face an opposing team in a quick round of competition. Trivia questions will be read aloud. Teams have five seconds to buzz in and answer the question. The team will have ten seconds to answer the question.

The team that buzzes in first will have the first opportunity to answer the question. If they cannot answer the question, or if they answer incorrectly, the question will go to the other team for a chance to steal the points. Correct answers are worth one point. Teams may collaborate before answering the question. There will be no audience support or help to answer questions.

Should there be a tie at the end of a round, the tie will be broken with one sudden death question. If the team buzzing in answers the question correctly, they win. If they answer incorrectly, the other team will be declared the winner.

### Check-In

Teams must check in for competition at the beginning of the Monday night social activity. Teams will sit in designated seating and be called on stage in random order. If a team is not present when called they will forfeit and the opposing team will be designated the winner.
