Our state pin design competition is open to all dues-paying student members and advisors in DECA. The winning design will provide inspiration and direction for our official state trading pin for the 2011 International Career Development Conference. Only one winner will be selected. All entries must be submitted to DECA exactly as directed in the rules below and all entries become the property of Oregon DECA once submitted.

Eligibility

This competition is open to all active Oregon DECA student members and advisors who are enrolled in DECA with an active chapter.

Deadline

ALL entries must be received by Oregon DECA by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 2, 2011.

Judging

All entries will be judged by Oregon DECA state staff and state officers. The winner of the competition will be announced to all chapters via email.

Specifications

All entries MUST include the following wording:

- Oregon or Oregon DECA

The design should incorporate a theme relating to the state of Oregon or the ICDC 2011 location. All copyright and trademark laws must be followed in the creation of the design. The lapel can be nearly any shape as long as it is no bigger than .75 inches tall and .75 inches wide. It can consist of up to four colors. Try to limit detail as it may be unclear on such a small area.

Please label all entries with the following (this can be included with the submitting email or included in the actual file where the design appears):

- Artist's name
- School name, address and phone number
- Advisor's name
- Email address

Oregon DECA will use the winning submission as inspiration for the ultimate pin design. This means that the final pin design may not appear exactly the same as that submitted by the winning entrant. Oregon DECA retains the right to make modifications to the final design as necessary in order to produce a pin to our standards and to the manufacturer's specifications and abilities. Incomplete entries that do not comply with the above requirements will be disqualified.

Entry File Format

Ideally the design should be submitted as an Illustrator or EPS file. If this is not possible, please submit the artwork as a JPEG image. Please be sure that the image is high quality and high resolution (generally 300 dpi is preferred).
